## Code of Ethics

*Advancing the World of Petroleum Geosciences.*

## AAPG CODE OF ETHICS

### General Principles

1. Geology is a profession, and the privilege of professional practice requires professional morality and professional responsibility.
2. Honesty, integrity, loyalty, fairness, impartiality, candor, fidelity to trust, and inviolability of confidence are incumbent upon every member as professional obligations.
3. Each member shall be guided by high standards of business ethics, personal honor, and professional conduct. The word "member" as used throughout this code includes all classes of membership.

### Relation of Members to the Public

1. Members shall not make false, misleading, or unwarranted statements, representations or claims in regard to professional matters, nor shall they engage in false or deceptive advertising.
2. Members shall not permit the publication or

conflicts of interest that may arise from information gained during geological investigations.

### Relation of Members to One Another

1. Members shall not falsely or maliciously attempt to injure the reputation or business of others.
2. Members shall freely recognize the work done by others, avoid plagiarism, and avoid the acceptance of credit due others.
3. Members shall endeavor to cooperate with others in the profession and shall encourage the ethical dissemination of geological knowledge.

### Duty to the Association

1. Members of the Association shall aid in preventing the election to membership of those who are unqualified or do not meet the standards set forth in this Code of Ethics.

## **3.3.4 Joint Society, Partner, Co-Sponsored or Endorsed Events**

These are events in which AAPG HQ, Regional Offices and/or an AAPG Region are joined, contract with, or cooperate with, one or more organizations or companies for the purpose of conducting an event. The IPTC is an example of this type of event.

The following key elements are to be considered. The event:

- does not directly compete with or overlap a scheduled, relevant AAPG global, regional, topical or joint society or partner event
- advances the geosciences or the image of the Association
- does not jeopardize AAPG's not-for-profit status
- does not offer direct or implied endorsements to commercial services or products
- places no financial risk on AAPG, unless previously approved by the AAPG Executive Committee or is included in the regular budgeting processes
- has technology and pricing structures compatible with members' expectations
- offers previously unrealized benefits to members in a topical or geographic area.

AAPG will receive a fee (the amount of which is negotiated prior to the event) from the revenue or a percent of the net revenue generated by both the event and/or the exhibition to recover costs incurred by AAPG and in recognition that the AAPG Name has value. The fee shall not be set so high as to discourage these initiatives.
